Oxfordshire Lowland Search and Rescue (OxSAR) is a volunteer unit (charity 1144058), working with Thames Valley Police to find vulnerable missing people in Oxfordshire. OxSAR is a member of ALSAR, the Association of Lowland Search and Rescue.

In 2016 OxSAR received 59 calls, one of the highest in the UK.

It currently has about 60 operational members who are available 24/7, 365 days of the year.
